- 2. An Any educational deficiency $\underline{\text{that}}$ which substantially affects a person's ability to read and comprehend the terms of any contractual agreement entered into.
- <u>(a) (d)</u> "Major life activities" means functions associated with the normal activities of independent daily living, such as caring for one's self, performing manual tasks, walking, seeing, hearing, speaking, breathing, learning, and working.
- (c) "Military service member" means a person who is on active duty in or a veteran of the United States Armed Forces.
 - 1. "Active duty" has the same meaning as in s. 250.01.
 - 2. "Veteran" has the same meaning as in s. 1.01.
- (2) A Any person who is willfully using, or has willfully used, a method, act, or practice in violation of this part, which method, act, or practice victimizes or attempts to victimize a senior citizen citizens or a person who has a disability handicapped persons, and commits such violation when she or he knew or should have known that her or his conduct was unfair or deceptive, is liable for a civil penalty of not more than \$15,000 for each such violation if she or he knew or should have known that her or his conduct was unfair or deceptive.
- (3) A person who willfully uses a method, act, or practice in violation of this part directed at a military service member or the spouse or child of a military service member is liable for a civil penalty of not more than \$15,000 for each violation if she or he should have known that her or his conduct was unfair or deceptive.

(5)(4) Civil penalties collected pursuant to this section shall be deposited into the Legal Affairs Revolving Trust Fund of the Department of Legal Affairs and allocated solely to the Department of Legal Affairs for the purpose of preparing and distributing consumer education materials, programs, and seminars to benefit senior citizens, and handicapped persons who have a disability, and military service members or to further enforcement efforts.
