(3) A person who is willfully using, or has willfully used, a method, act, or practice in violation of this part directed at a military service member or the spouse or child of a military service member, is liable for a civil penalty of not more than \$15,000 for each such violation if she or he knew or should have known that her or his conduct was unfair or deceptive.

(4) (3) An Any order of restitution or reimbursement based on a violation of this part committed against a senior citizen, a or handicapped person who has a disability, a military service member, or the spouse or child of a military service member has priority over the imposition of civil penalties for such violations pursuant to this section.
