16	or the spouse or dependent child of a military servicemember;

18	(1) As used in this section, the term:
19	<u>(a)</u> (d) "Major life activities" means functions associated
20	with the normal activities of independent daily living ${\scriptstyle \underline{\prime}}$ such as
21	caring for one's self, performing manual tasks, walking, seeing,
22	hearing, speaking, breathing, learning, and working.
23	(b) (c) "Mental or educational impairment" means:
24	1. <u>A</u> Any mental or psychological disorder or specific
25	learning disability.
26	2. An Any educational deficiency that which substantially
27	affects a person's ability to read and comprehend the terms of
28	any contractual agreement entered into.
