An act relating to the Florida Forest Service; amending s. 589.11, F.S.; deleting authority of the Florida Forest Service to operate a seedling tree nursery program and to sell seedling trees to the public for purposes of the federal Clarke-McNary Law; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 589.11, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
589.11 Duties of Florida Forest Service as to Clarke-McNary Law.-
(1) The Florida Forest Service is designated and authorized as the agent of the state to cooperate with the United States Secretary of Agriculture under the provisions of "ss. 4 and 5, Chapter 348, 43 Statutes 654, Acts of Congress, June 7, 1924, known as the Clarke-McNary Law," to assist owners of farms in establishing, improving, and renewing woodlots, shelterbelts, windbreaks, and other valuable forest growth; in growing and renewing useful timber crops; and to cooperate with the woodusing industries or other agencies, governmental or otherwise, interested in proper land use, forest management, and conservative forest utilization.
(2) As a means of providing seedling trees for the purposes of this section, the Florida Forest Service is authorized to operate a seedling tree nursexy program and to set reasonable prices for the sale to the public of seedling trees. Receipts
