Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 466.006, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

466.006 Examination of dentists.-

8 (3) If an applicant is a graduate of a dental college or 9 school not accredited in accordance with paragraph (2)(b) or of 10 a dental college or school not approved by the board, the 11 applicant is not entitled to take the examinations required in 12 this section to practice dentistry <u>unless the applicant</u> until 13 she or he satisfies one of the following <u>requirements</u>: Florida Senate - 2013 Bill No. CS for SB 1302



(a) Completes a program of study, as defined by the board by rule, at an accredited American dental school and demonstrates receipt of a D.D.S. or D.M.D. from <u>that</u> said school; or

(b) Submits proof of having successfully completed at least 18 2 consecutive academic years in at a full-time supplemental 19 general dentistry program taught at an institution accredited by 20 the American Dental Association Commission on Dental 21 22 Accreditation. This program must provide didactic and clinical 23 education at the level of a D.D.S. or D.M.D. program accredited 24 by the American Dental Association Commission on Dental 25 Accreditation. For purposes of this paragraph, a supplemental 26 general dentistry program does not include dental specialty 27 programs. A supplemental general dentistry program may include a 28 2-year advanced education in general dentistry program or a 2-29 year general practice residency program if the program is 30 specifically designed as a supplemental general dentistry program that provides didactic and clinical education at the 31 32 level of a D.D.S. or D.M.D. program; or 33 (c)1. Was enrolled on March 23, 2012, in a dental specialty 34 program recognized by the American Dental Association, 35 maintained continuous enrollment until successfully completing 36 the program, and meets the following requirements: 37 a. Completes a full-time matriculated specialty training 38 program accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation in 39 a specialty area recognized by the American Dental Association; 40 and b. Presents to the board official transcripts that verify 41 42 completion of all didactic and clinical requirements and an
