An act relating to malt beverages; amending s. 563.06,

F.S.; authorizing an additional size for individual containers of malt beverages sold or offered for sale by vendors at retail; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (7) of section 563.06, Florida Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (8), and subsection (6) of that section is amended to read:

563.06 Malt beverages; imprint on individual container; size of containers; exemptions.-

- (6) All malt beverages packaged in individual containers sold or offered for sale by vendors at retail in this state shall be in individual containers containing 64 ounces, or a lesser size containing no more than 32 ounces, of such malt beverages. Such containers may be filled at the point of sale by either a licensed manufacturer or a vendor licensed for consumption on the premises but must have an unbroken seal or be incapable of being immediately consumed.; provided, however, that nothing contained in
- (7) This section does not shall affect malt beverages packaged in bulk, or in kegs or in barrels, or in an any individual container containing 1 gallon or more of such malt beverage regardless of individual container type.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
