Electronic transmission of a policy for commercial 23 risks, including, but not limited to, workers' compensation and 24 employers' liability, commercial automobile liability, 25 commercial automobile physical damage, commercial lines 26 residential property, commercial nonresidential property, farm 27 owners' insurance, and the types of commercial lines risks set forth in s. 627.062(3)(d), shall constitute delivery to the 28
