Section 1. Subsection (8) of section 402.305, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

402.305 Licensing standards; child care facilities.-

- (8) NUTRITIONAL PRACTICES.—Minimum standards shall include requirements for the provision of meals or snacks of a quality and quantity to assure that the nutritional needs of the child are met. Such standards shall include at least the following requirements:
- (a) Only 1 percent milk or nonfat milk shall be served to children 2 years of age or older unless otherwise ordered by a physician or health practitioner.
- (b) One hundred percent fruit juice shall be limited to no more than one serving per day.
- (c) A beverage with added sweeteners, natural or artificial, may not be served.
- (d) Clean and safe drinking water must be readily available and accessible throughout the day.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
