Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Section 871.015, Florida Statutes, is created to read:
  - 871.015 Unlawful protests.-
  - (1) As used in this section, the term:
- (a) "Funeral, burial, or memorial service" means any service offered or provided in connection with the final disposition, memorialization, interment, entombment, or inurnment of human remains or cremated human remains.
- (b) "Protest activities" means any action, including picketing, that is undertaken with the intent to interrupt or disturb a funeral, burial, or memorial service.
- (2) A person may not knowingly engage in protest activities or knowingly cause protest activities to occur within 500 feet of the property line of any residence, cemetery, funeral home, house of worship, or other location during or within 1 hour before or 1 hour after the conducting of a funeral, burial, or memorial service at that place.
- (3) A person who violates this section commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s.
