A bill to be entitled An act relating to the Department of Transportation; requiring the department to adopt rules governing use of the department's excess fiber optic communication networks for nontransportation purposes; providing an effective date. Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: Section 1. Department of Transportation policy for use of excess data transmission capacity.-By July 1, 2014, the Department of Transportation shall adopt rules governing the use of the department's excess fiber optic communication networks by local governmental entities for nontransportation purposes. The rules must comply with state law and, if applicable, federal regulations governing property acquired with federal aid. The rules may allow, but are not required to allow, any such nontransportation use. However, if such nontransportation use is allowed, the rules must: (1) Provide for an interlocal agreement to define the agreed to parameters for use of the department's fiber optic network. The agreement shall define each party's respective rights and roles and must preserve the department's right to terminate the agreement if the right-of-way area occupied by the fiber is subsequently required for transportation purposes. (2) Establish a statewide policy for the allowed use of the fiber optic network. The policy must be consistent with
