Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert: Section 1. Paragraphs (d) and (e) of subsection (1), paragraphs (e) and (f) of subsection (2), and paragraphs (b) and (c) of subsection (3) of section 320.0848, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

11 320.0848 Persons who have disabilities; issuance of 12 disabled parking permits; temporary permits; permits for certain 13 providers of transportation services to persons who have 14 disabilities.-

(1) (a) The department of Highway Safety and Motor
Vehicles or its authorized agents shall, upon application and
receipt of the fee, issue a disabled parking permit for a period
of up to 4 years, which period ends on the applicant's birthday,
to any person who has long-term mobility impairment, including a
