7	WHEREAS, men have a 1 in 27 chance and women have a 1 in 86
8	chance of being diagnosed with bladder cancer in their lifetime,

11	70,000 new cases of bladder cancer are diagnosed and nearly
12	14,000 people die from the disease, and
13	WHEREAS, bladder cancer occurs in more women annually than
14	cervical cancer, and
15	WHEREAS, women often have a delayed diagnosis due to
16	bladder cancer being mistaken for common gynecological problems,
17	and
18	WHEREAS, although bladder cancer can occur at any age, a
19	high percentage of people suffering from the disease are over
20	the age of 55, and
21	WHEREAS, due to a nearly 80 percent recurrence rate,
