- (3) (a) The commission is composed of 13 members who are appointed in the following manner:
- 1. The Governor shall appoint three members, one of whom represents an institution of higher learning, one of whom represents the Florida African-American Heritage Preservation Network, and one of whom represents business and civic interests in the African-American community.
 - 2. The President of the Senate shall appoint two members,

one of whom is involved in instructional design in a school district or in an institution of higher learning and one of whom is an employee of a museum of African-American history in this state.

- 3. The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint two members, one of whom has a substantial history of community service in the performing or visual arts in the African-American community and one of whom is an employee of a museum of African-American history in this state.
- 4. The Secretary of State shall appoint two members who are directors of museums of African-American history or black archives and research centers in this state.
- 5. The Commissioner of Education shall appoint two members who are members of the Commissioner of Education's African American History Task Force.
- 6. The Florida Conference of Black State Legislators shall appoint two members, one of whom is a representative of a philanthropic foundation and one of whom is a member of the clergy.
