and insert:

Section 18. Paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (4) of section 102.031, Florida Statutes, are amended, and paragraph (d) is added to that subsection, to read:

8 (4)(a) No person, political committee, committee of 9 continuous existence, or other group or organization may solicit 10 voters inside the polling place or within 100 feet of the 11 entrance to any polling place, or <u>a</u> polling room where the 12 polling place is also a polling room, or <u>an</u> early voting site<u>,</u> 13 <u>or an office of the supervisor of elections where absentee</u> Florida Senate - 2013 Bill No. CS for CS for SB 600



14 <u>ballots are requested and printed on demand for the convenience</u> 15 <u>of electors who appear in person to request them</u>. Before the 16 opening of the polling place or early voting site, the clerk or 17 supervisor shall designate the no-solicitation zone and mark the 18 boundaries.
