Amendment to Amendment (906024) (with title amendment)

Remove lines 241-274 of the amendment and insert:

(2) A high-performing charter school is authorized to:

(a) Increase its student enrollment once per school year by up to 15 percent more than the capacity identified in the charter.

(b) Expand grade levels within kindergarten through grade 12 to add grade levels not already served if any annual enrollment increase resulting from grade level expansion is within the limit established in paragraph (a).

(c) Submit a quarterly, rather than a monthly, financial statement to the sponsor pursuant to s. 1002.33(9)(g).

(d) Consolidate under a single charter the charters of multiple high-performing charter schools operated in the same

17 school district by the charter schools' governing board
18 regardless of the renewal cycle.

19 (e) Receive a modification of its charter to a term of 15
20 years or a 15-year charter renewal. The charter may be modified
21 or renewed for a shorter term at the option of the high-
22 performing charter school. The charter must be consistent with
23 s. 1002.33(7)(a)19. and (10)(h) and (i), is subject to annual
24 review by the sponsor, and may be terminated during its term
25 pursuant to s. 1002.33(8).

27 A high-performing charter school shall notify its sponsor in
28 writing by March 1 if it intends to increase enrollment or
29 expand grade levels the following school year. The written
30 notice shall specify the amount of the enrollment increase and
