Section 720.3086, Florida Statutes, is amended 10 to read: 720.303 11 12 720.3086 Financial report.-In a residential subdivision in 13 which the owners of lots or parcels must pay mandatory 14 maintenance or amenity fees to the subdivision developer or to 15 the owners of the common areas, recreational facilities, and 16 other properties serving the lots or parcels, the developer or 17 owner of such areas, facilities, or properties shall make 18 public, within 60 days following the end of each fiscal year, a 19 complete financial report of the actual, total receipts of 20 mandatory maintenance or amenity fees received by it, if the 21 receipts exceed \$200,000 for that year, and an itemized listing 22 of the expenditures made by it from such fees, for that year. 23 Such report shall be made public by mailing it to each lot or 24 parcel owner in the subdivision, by publishing it in a 25 publication regularly distributed within the subdivision, or by 26 posting it in prominent locations in the subdivision. This 27 section does not apply to amounts paid to homeowner associations 28 pursuant to chapter 617, chapter 718, chapter 719, chapter 721,

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29 or chapter 723, or to amounts paid to local governmental

30 entities, including special districts.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.

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
