Section 11. Paragraph (a) of subsection (3) and paragraph (c) of subsection (5) of section 316.515, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

316.515 Maximum width, height, length.-

9 LENGTH LIMITATION.-Except as otherwise provided in (3) 10 this section, length limitations apply solely to a semitrailer 11 or trailer, and not to a truck tractor or to the overall length of a combination of vehicles. No combination of commercial motor 12 vehicles coupled together and operating on the public roads may 13 consist of more than one truck tractor and two trailing units. 14 Unless otherwise specifically provided for in this section, a 15 16 combination of vehicles not qualifying as commercial motor

17 vehicles may consist of no more than two units coupled together; 18 such nonqualifying combination of vehicles may not exceed a 19 total length of 65 feet, inclusive of the load carried thereon, 20 but exclusive of safety and energy conservation devices approved 21 by the department for use on vehicles using public roads. 22 Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a truck 23 tractor-semitrailer combination engaged in the transportation of 24 automobiles or boats may transport motor vehicles or boats on 25 part of the power unit; and, except as may otherwise be mandated 26 under federal law, an automobile or boat transporter semitrailer 27 may not exceed 50 feet in length, exclusive of the load; 28 however, the load may extend up to an additional 6 feet beyond the rear of the trailer. The 50-feet length limitation does not 29 30 apply to non-stinger-steered automobile or boat transporters 31 that are 65 feet or less in overall length, exclusive of the 32 load carried thereon, or to stinger-steered automobile or boat transporters that are 75 feet or less in overall length, 33 34 exclusive of the load carried thereon. For purposes of this 35 subsection, a "stinger-steered automobile or boat transporter" 36 is an automobile or boat transporter configured as a semitrailer 37 combination wherein the fifth wheel is located on a drop frame 38 located behind and below the rearmost axle of the power unit. 39 Notwithstanding paragraphs (a) and (b), any straight truck or truck tractor-semitrailer combination engaged in the 40 41 transportation of horticultural trees may allow the load to extend up to an additional 10 feet beyond the rear of the 42 43 vehicle, provided said trees are resting against a retaining bar mounted above the truck bed so that the root balls of the trees 44

45 rest on the floor and to the front of the truck bed and the tops 46 of the trees extend up over and to the rear of the truck bed, 47 and provided the overhanging portion of the load is covered with 48 protective fabric.

49 Straight trucks.-A straight truck may not exceed a (a) 50 length of 40 feet in extreme overall dimension, exclusive of 51 safety and energy conservation devices approved by the 52 department for use on vehicles using public roads. A straight 53 truck may attach a forklift to the rear of the cargo bed, 54 provided the overall combined length of the vehicle and the 55 forklift does not exceed 50 feet. A straight truck may tow no 56 more than one trailer, and the overall length of the truck-57 trailer combination may not exceed 68 feet, including the load 58 thereon. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, a 59 truck-trailer combination engaged in the transportation of 60 boats, or boat trailers whose design dictates a front-to-rear stacking method may not exceed the length limitations of this 61 paragraph exclusive of the load; however, the load may extend up 62 63 to an additional 6 feet beyond the rear of the trailer.
