28 29 An act relating to charter schools; amending s. 1002.33, F.S.; requiring the compensation and salary schedules for charter school employees to be based on school district schedules; providing salary restrictions in certain instances; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (16) of section 1002.33, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
 - 1002.33 Charter schools.-
 - (16) EXEMPTION FROM STATUTES.—
- (b) Additionally, a charter school shall be in compliance with the following statutes:
- 1. Section 286.011, relating to public meetings and records, public inspection, and criminal and civil penalties.
 - 2. Chapter 119, relating to public records.
- 3. Section 1003.03, relating to the maximum class size, except that the calculation for compliance pursuant to s. 1003.03 shall be the average at the school level.
- 4. Section 1012.22(1)(c), relating to compensation and salary schedules. The compensation and salary schedules for instructional personnel and school administrators hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall be based on the schedules of the school district in which the charter school is located. If a school district does not have compensation and salary schedules, the salary of a charter school employee may not exceed the

- 5. Section 1012.33(5), relating to workforce reductions.
- 6. Section 1012.335, relating to contracts with instructional personnel hired on or after July 1, 2011.
