456.031 Requirement for instruction on domestic violence.-

10 (1) (a) The appropriate board shall require each person licensed or certified under chapter 458, chapter 459, part I of 11 chapter 464, chapter 466, chapter 467, chapter 490, or chapter 12 13 491 to complete no later than upon first renewal a 2-hour 14 continuing education course, approved by the board, on domestic violence, as defined in s. 741.28, as part of every third 15 16 biennial relicensure or recertification. Those individuals who 17 have previously completed an approved domestic violence 18 continuing education course are exempt from this section. Each licensing board that requires a licensee to complete an educational course pursuant to this subsection may include the hour required for completion of the course in the total hours of continuing education required by law for such profession unless
