2	A resolution recognizing the honorable service and
3	sacrifice of Florida's Vietnam veterans.

5	WHEREAS, the Vietnam War took place in Vietnam, Laos, and
6	Cambodia from November 1, 1955, until the United States Congress
7	passed the Case-Church amendment in 1973, which prohibited the
8	further use of American military forces in the area, and
9	WHEREAS, because of the intense public opposition to the
10	war that existed at the time, members of the United States Armed
11	Services returned home to an unprecedented lack of formal
12	positive recognition of their honorable service and the
13	tremendous sacrifices they had made on behalf of their country,
14	and
15	WHEREAS, the lack of formal "Welcome Home" parades and
16	other traditional celebrations that were common for United
17	States soldiers returning from previous military engagements,
18	coupled with verbal and sometimes physical abuse, resulted in
19	great disillusionment, undeserved indignity, and often great
20	suffering and anguish among returning Vietnam veterans, and
21	WHEREAS, as of July 2011, the Department of Veterans'
22	Affairs estimated that there were approximately 454,000 Vietnam-
23	era veterans living in the State of Florida, and
24	WHEREAS, as March 30, 2013, marks the official date of the
25	40th anniversary of the end of the United States' involvement ir
26	the Vietnam War, this state is presented with a unique and
27	historic opportunity to hold appropriate observances and long-
28	overdue recognition ceremonies that will honor Florida's aging

Vietnam War veterans and that may finally provide these brave men and women a fitting expression of gratitude and a measure of healing and official closure that has been denied them for decades and that they so greatly deserve, and

33 WHEREAS, the importance of the commemoration of this 34 historic anniversary and the opportunity to attempt to rectify 35 past injustices and ingratitude cannot be stressed strongly 36 enough, and

37 WHEREAS, it is fitting and appropriate that the House of 38 Representatives encourage and support efforts within the state 39 to mark this historic anniversary and to attempt to redress the 40 lack of appropriate recognition and undeserved ingratitude that 41 so many of these brave servicemen and servicewomen received upon 42 returning home, NOW, THEREFORE,

44 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of 45 Florida:

47 That in recognition of the 40th anniversary of the end of the United States' involvement in the Vietnam War on March 30, 48 2013, Florida's state agencies and officials, counties, 49 50 municipalities, and community organizations are called upon and 51 encouraged to publicly acknowledge and demonstrate the state's 52 appreciation for the honorable service and sacrifice of its 53 Vietnam veterans through such activities as issuing appropriate 54 resolutions and holding or providing support for special 55 recognitions throughout the year.
