A resolution designating April 15-20, 2013, as "Haitian American Nurses Awareness Week" in Florida.

5 WHEREAS, in 1984, two registered professional nurses 6 practicing in Miami, Alice Casimir and Jacqueline Dasque, saw 7 the need to establish an organization that would provide health 8 care services to migrant workers in the Homestead area and, 9 along with other professionals, founded the Haitian American 10 Nurses Association of Florida, Inc., and

WHEREAS, this nonprofit membership organization was 11 12 established in order to provide Haitian nurses with the 13 opportunity to unite as a group, to share and provide ideas of 14 interest to the profession of nursing, and to become effectively involved with the issues and services relevant to the health and 15 16 welfare of Florida's Haitian community, goals that were 17 significantly furthered at the association's first annual 18 nursing convention in 2012, held at Miami Dade College and 19 entitled "Empowering Future Nurse Leaders through Mentoring, 20 Caring, and Leadership," and

21 WHEREAS, the Haitian American Nurses Association of 22 Florida, Inc., strives to increase the enrollment of Haitian 23 students in nursing schools in both Florida and Haiti through 24 nursing scholarships, educational and mentoring opportunities, 25 and facilitation of community networking among its members, and

26 WHEREAS, in collaboration with other community 27 organizations, the association provides culturally sensitive 28 care while promoting health and wellness through its various
