Senate House

Senator Latvala moved the following:

## Senate Amendment to Amendment (495738) (with title amendment)

Delete lines 23 - 41

and insert:

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- (15) (a) Except as provided by this section, the department may not designate trauma centers in addition to those designated as of April 25, 2013 in:
- 1. A county where a Level I trauma center operates as of April 25, 2013; or
- 2. A location within 8 miles by ground transport of an existing Level I trauma center; or
  - 3. A location within 45 miles by ground transport of a

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Level I trauma center that is owned and operated by a statutory teaching hospital as of April 25, 2013.

- (b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), the department shall designate additional trauma centers that meet the applicable trauma center standards if:
- 1. The hospital that seeks designation as a Level II trauma center is not located within 8 miles by ground transport of an existing Level I trauma center and demonstrates a formal trauma affiliation agreement with a hospital located in the same county that is designated as a Level I trauma center as of April 25, 2013;
- 2. The hospital that seeks designation as a Level I trauma center was designated as a Level II trauma center as of January 1, 1999, and is owned and operated by a statutory teaching hospital; or
- 3. The hospital that seeks designation as a trauma center is located within 45 miles by ground transport of a hospital that, as of April 25, 2013, has a Level I trauma center and is owned and operated by a statutory teaching hospital and:
- a. Demonstrates that it will share a license number and license certificate number with the statutory teaching hospital; or
- b. Demonstrates a formal trauma affiliation agreement with the statutory teaching hospital.
- (c) Any formal trauma affiliation agreement required by this section must be in compliance with statutory requirements to maintain an inclusive trauma system and must address the acceptance of all medically necessary transfers, clinical protocols, and other clinical arrangements appropriate for the
