(2) A person who applies to take the licensure examination more than 1 year after satisfying the educational requirements specified in subsection (1) must complete a licensure examination preparatory course approved by the board before being approved for examination.

(3)(2) Each applicant who passes the examination and provides proof of meeting the educational requirements specified in subsection (1) shall, unless denied pursuant to s. 464.018, be entitled to licensure as a registered professional nurse or a licensed practical nurse, <u>as whichever is</u> applicable.

55 (4) (3) An Any applicant who fails the examination three 56 consecutive times, regardless of the jurisdiction in which the 57 examination is taken, must shall be required to complete a 58 board-approved remedial course before the applicant may will be 59 approved for reexamination. After taking the remedial course, 60 the applicant may be approved to retake the examination up to three additional times before the applicant is required to 61 62 retake remediation. The applicant shall apply for reexamination within 6 months after completion of remediation. The board shall 63 64 by rule establish guidelines for remedial courses.
