13	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

15	Section 1. Subsections (1) and (4) of section 1009.60,
16	Florida Statutes, are amended to read:
17	1009.60 Minority teacher education scholars programThere
18	is created the minority teacher education scholars program,
19	which is a collaborative performance-based scholarship program
20	for African-American, Hispanic-American, Asian-American, and
21	Native American students. The participants in the program
22	include Florida's Florida College System institutions and its
23	public and private universities that have teacher education
24	programs.
25	(1) The minority teacher education scholars program shall
26	provide an annual scholarship in an amount that shall be
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27 prorated based on available appropriations and may not exceed 28 \$4,000 for each approved minority teacher education scholar who 29 is enrolled in one of Florida's public or private <u>colleges or</u> 30 universities, <u>in the junior year and</u> is admitted into a teacher 31 education program, <u>and has not earned more than 18 credit hours</u> 32 <u>of upper-division education courses</u>.

33 (4) A student may receive a scholarship from the program 34 for 3 consecutive years if the student remains enrolled full-35 time in the program and makes satisfactory progress toward a 36 baccalaureate degree with a major in education <u>or a graduate</u> 37 degree with a major in education.

38 Section 2. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section 39 1009.605, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as paragraph (c) and 40 amended, a new paragraph (b) is added to that subsection, 41 subsection (3) is amended, and subsection (4) is added to that 42 section, to read:

45 (b) By June 30 of each year, the corporation shall submit 46 a report to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the 47 House of Representatives comprising a comparative history of the 48 following information for each fiscal year, beginning with the 49 2008-2009 fiscal year: the amount of funds appropriated, the number of scholarships awarded, the number of scholarship 50 51 recipients currently fulfilling their Florida teaching 52 commitment, the number of scholarship recipients who have

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53 <u>completed their Florida teaching commitment, the number of</u> 54 <u>scholarship recipients who have defaulted on the scholarship,</u> 55 <u>the balance of the unpaid scholarship funds, and the total</u> 56 <u>amount of scholarship funds that have been repaid.</u>

57 (c) (b) The corporation shall report to the Department of 58 Education, by the date established by the department, the 59 eligible students to whom scholarship moneys are disbursed each 60 academic term, the annual balance of the corporation's assets 61 and cash reserves, and any other information requested by the department in accordance with s. 1009.94. By June 30 of each 62 63 fiscal year, the corporation shall remit to the department any appropriated funds that were not distributed for scholarships, 64 less the funds 5 percent for administration pursuant to 65 subsection (3) and the funds for the training program required 66 67 in subsection (4), including administration of the required 68 training program, authorized pursuant to subsection (3).

69 (3) A board of directors shall administer the corporation. 70 The Governor shall appoint to the board at least 15 but not more 71 than 25 members, who shall serve terms of 3 years, except that 4 72 of the initial members shall serve 1-year terms and 4 shall 73 serve 2-year terms. At least 4 members must be employed by 74 Florida College System institutions and at least 11 members must 75 be employed by public or private postsecondary institutions that 76 operate colleges of education. At least one member must be a 77 financial aid officer employed by a postsecondary education 78 institution operating in Florida. Administrative costs for Page 3 of 4

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79 support of the Board of Directors and the Florida Fund for 80 Minority Teachers may not exceed \$100,000 5 percent of funds allocated for the program. The executive director shall be the chief 87 administrative officer and agent of the board. Maintain a record of its proceedings. 88 (e) 89 (f) Delegate to the chairperson the responsibility for 90 signing final orders. 91 (g) Carry out the training program as required for the 92 minority teacher education scholars program. No more than 5 93 percent of the funds appropriated and up to \$100,000 from other 94 available funds for the minority teacher education scholars 95 program may be expended annually for administration, including 96 administration of the required training program. 97 (4) The board of directors shall carry out a training 98 program as required for the minority teacher education scholars 99 program. Up to \$100,000 from appropriated funds and other available funds for the minority teacher education scholars 100 101 program may be expended annually for the required training 102 program. 103 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
