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Section 7. Present subsections (11) through (18) of section 553.79, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as subsections (12) through (19), respectively, a new subsection (11) is added to that section, and present subsection (18) is amended, to read: 553.79 Permits; applications; issuance; inspections.-(11) The local enforcing agency may not issue a building Florida Senate - 2014 Bill No. CS for SB 1106

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11 permit to construct, develop, or modify a public swimming pool 12 without proof of application for an operating permit under s. 13 514.031. A certificate of completion or occupancy may not be 14 issued until such operating permit is issued.

15 <u>(19) (18)</u> For the purpose of inspection and record 16 retention, site plans <u>or building permits</u> for a building may be 17 maintained in the <u>original</u> form <u>or in the form</u> of an electronic 18 copy at the worksite. These plans <u>and permits</u> must be open to 19 inspection by the building official or a duly authorized 20 representative, as required by the Florida Building Code.

21 Section 8. Section 440.103, Florida Statutes, is amended to 22 read:

23 440.103 Building permits; identification of minimum premium 24 policy.-Every employer shall, as a condition to applying for and 25 receiving a building permit, show proof and certify to the 26 permit issuer that it has secured compensation for its employees 27 under this chapter as provided in ss. 440.10 and 440.38. Such 28 proof of compensation must be evidenced by a certificate of 29 coverage issued by the carrier, a valid exemption certificate 30 approved by the department, or a copy of the employer's 31 authority to self-insure and shall be presented, electronically 32 or physically, each time the employer applies for a building 33 permit. As provided in s. 553.79(19), for the purpose of inspection and record retention, site plans or building permits 34 35 may be maintained at the worksite in the original form or in the 36 form of an electronic copy. These plans and permits must be open 37 to inspection by the building official or a duly authorized 38 representative, as required by the Florida Building Code. As 39 provided in s. 627.413(5), each certificate of coverage must

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40	show, on its face, whether or not coverage is secured under the
41	minimum premium provisions of rules adopted by rating
42	organizations licensed pursuant to s. 627.221. The words
43	"minimum premium policy" or equivalent language shall be typed,
44	printed, stamped, or legibly handwritten.
