Basic rights.-All natural persons, female and 18 male alike, are equal before the law and have inalienable 19 rights, among which are the right to enjoy and defend life and liberty, to pursue happiness, to be rewarded for industry, and 20 21 to acquire, possess, and protect property; except that the 22 ownership, inheritance, disposition and possession of real 23 property by aliens incligible for citizenship may be regulated 24 or prohibited by law. No person shall be deprived of any right 25 because of race, religion, national origin, or physical 26 disability.

35	aliens ineligible for citizenship. The State Constitution will
36	now provide that all natural persons are equal before the law
37	and have an inalienable right to acquire, possess, and protect
38	property, without exception.
