Curricular content for all subjects must integrate critical-thinking, problem-solving, and workforce-literacy 46 47 skills; communication, reading, and writing skills; mathematics 48 skills; collaboration skills; contextual and applied-learning 49 skills; technology-literacy skills; information and media-50 literacy skills; and civic-engagement skills.
