A bill to be entitled

An act relating to identification cards and driver licenses; amending s. 322.141, F.S.; providing that a medical alert logo may be placed on the face of an identification card or driver license issued to a person with a medical condition; directing the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to require proof of such medical condition; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 322.141, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

322.141 Color or markings of certain licenses or identification cards.—

(2) (a) All licenses for the operation of motor vehicles originally issued or reissued by the department to persons who have insulin-dependent diabetes may, at the request of the applicant, have distinctive markings separate and distinct from all other licenses issued by the department.

(b) An identification card or driver license originally issued or reissued by the department to a person who has a medical condition may, at the request of the applicant, include a medical alert logo on the face of the identification card or license.

 $\underline{\text{(c)}}$ At the time of application for original license or reissue, the department shall require such proof as it deems appropriate that a person has insulin-dependent diabetes $\underline{\text{or}}$
