Between lines 146 and 147

insert:

Section 4. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 465.189,  
Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

465.189 Administration of vaccines and epinephrine  
autoinjection.—

(1) In accordance with guidelines of the Centers for  
Disease Control and Prevention for each recommended immunization  
or vaccine, a pharmacist may administer the following vaccines
