An act relating to land conservation; limiting the ability of the state, a county, or a municipality to purchase land outside an area of critical concern for conservation purposes; providing criteria; exempting purchases of land if they are approved by referendum or if the land is purchased for active public use; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) The state may purchase land outside an area of critical state concern for conservation purposes only if:

- (a) An accurate inventory, conducted within the last 12 months, of state-owned property is made publicly available;
- (b) Sufficient funds are approved in the state's annual budget for the restoration and maintenance of existing properties;
- (c) A description of the current use of existing properties and an analysis of proposed future uses of existing properties are made publicly available; and
- (d) An analysis by the state describing the annual cost of restoration and maintenance of the proposed land purchase is completed and made publicly available, and funds sufficient to restore and maintain the proposed land purchase are approved and set aside.
- (2) A purchase of land by the state is exempt from this section if it is approved by referendum or if the land is purchased for active public use.

Section 2. (1) A county may purchase land outside an area of critical state concern for conservation purposes only if:

- (a) An accurate inventory, conducted within the last 12 months, of county-owned property is made publicly available;
- (b) Sufficient funds are approved in the county's annual budget for the restoration and maintenance of existing properties;
- (c) A description of the current use of existing properties and an analysis of proposed future uses of existing properties are made publicly available; and
- (d) An analysis by the county describing the annual cost of restoration and maintenance of the proposed land purchase is completed and made publicly available, and funds sufficient to restore and maintain the proposed land purchase are approved and set aside.
- (2) A purchase of land by the county is exempt from this section if it is approved by referendum or if the land is purchased for active public use.
- Section 3. (1) A municipality may purchase land outside an area of critical state concern for conservation purposes only if:
- (a) An accurate inventory, conducted within the last 12 months, of municipally owned property is made publicly available;
- (b) Sufficient funds are approved in the municipality's annual budget for the restoration and maintenance of existing properties;
- (c) A description of the current use of existing properties and an analysis of proposed future uses of existing properties

are made publicly available; and

- (d) An analysis by the municipality describing the annual cost of restoration and maintenance of the proposed land purchase is completed and made publicly available, and funds sufficient to restore and maintain the proposed land purchase are approved and set aside.
- (2) A purchase of land by the municipality is exempt from this section if it is approved by referendum or if the land is purchased for active public use.

Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
