26 development policies, such as Smart Growth, the Wildlands 27 Project, Resilient Cities, regional visioning projects, and 28 other green or alternative projects, and 29 WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Florida Legislature to 30 vigorously protect the interests of private property owners 31 through enactment of legislation such as the Bert J.
