27 civic organization up to 15 temporary permits per calendar year
28 authorizing the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on
29 the premises at outdoor events in the Ocala Downtown Community
30 Redevelopment Area. Such temporary permits shall be valid for up
31 to 3 days.

32 (3) To obtain a temporary permit under this act, a bona
33 fide nonprofit civic organization must:

34 (a) Present a valid resolution to the division from the
35 Ocala City Council which grants temporary approval for
36 possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages on municipally
37 owned property and authorizes closure of affected streets if
38 public rights-of-way are included in the permitted premises; and

39 (b) Comply with all other requirements of s. 561.422,
40 Florida Statutes.

41 (4) The temporary permits authorized by this act are in
42 addition to the temporary permits authorized per year for a bona
43 fide nonprofit civic organization pursuant to s. 561.422,
44 Florida Statutes.

45 (5) On or before October 1, 2014, the Division of
46 Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the Department of Business
47 and Professional Regulation shall adopt rules to administer this
48 act.

49 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
