Section 55. The governing body of a municipality that created a downtown development authority and was authorized to levy an additional ad valorem tax under chapter 65-1090, Laws of Florida, may continue to levy said additional ad valorem tax on all real and personal property in the downtown district of up to 0.5 mill for the purpose of financing the operation of the



12 authority. The levy of the ad valorem tax shall be in addition 13 to regular ad valorem taxes and special assessments for improvements imposed by the governing body of the municipality; 14 15 however, the combined levy may not exceed the maximum millage 16 authorized for municipal purposes under s. 9(b), Article VII of 17 the State Constitution.
