Section 1. Present subsections (8) and (9) of section 784.048, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (9) and (10), respectively, and a new subsection (8) is added to that section, to read:

784.048 Stalking; definitions; penalties.-

(8) A violation of s. 860.30 satisfies the element of willfully following for the purposes of this section.

Section 2. Section 860.30, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

860.30 Unauthorized installation of tracking device.-

- (1) Without the informed consent of the owner of a vehicle, a person may not install on a vehicle a tracking device that is able to:
- (a) Record and store a history of the physical location of the vehicle for later retrieval; or

30 (b) Transmit the physical location of the vehicle to another party.

- (2) A person who violates this section commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
- (3) This section does not limit the ability of a law enforcement officer or governmental entity to track the location of a vehicle; however, the law enforcement officer or governmental entity must first obtain a search warrant authorizing the placement of a tracking device.
  - Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
