An act relating to the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program; amending s. 1009.531, F.S.; revising student eligibility requirements for the Florida Medallion Scholars award; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (6) of section 1009.531, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
1009.531 Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program; student eligibility requirements for initial awards.-
(6)
(b) The State Board of Education shall publicize the examination score required for a student to be eligible for a Florida Medallion Scholars award, pursuant to s. 1009.535(1)(a) or (b), as follows:

1. For high school students graduating in the 2010-2011 academic year, the student must earn an SAT score of 970 or a concordant ACT score of 20 , or the student in a home education program whose parent cannot document a college-preparatory curriculum must earn an SAT score of 1070 or a concordant ACT score of 23.
2. For high school students graduating in the 2011-2012 academic year, the student must earn an SAT score of 980 which corresponds to the 44 th SAT percentile rank or a concordant ACT score of 21 , or the student in a home education program whose parent cannot document a college-preparatory curriculum must

3. For high school students graduating in the 2012-2013 academic year and thereafter, the student must earn an SAT score of 1020 which corresponds to the 51st SAT percentile rank or a concordant ACT score of 22 , or the student in a home education program whose parent cannot document a college-preparatory curriculum must earn an SAT score of 1070 or a concordant ACT score of 23.
4. For high school students graduating in the 2013-2014 academic year and thereafter, the student must earn an SAT seore of 1170 which corresponds to the 75 th SAT percentile rank or a eoncordant ACT score of 26 or the student in a home education program whose parent cannot document a college-proparatory eurriculum must carn an SAT score of 1220 or a concordant ACT score of 27.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
