12 Section 2. Subsection (2) of section 465.004, Florida
13 Statutes, is amended to read:

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465.004 Board of Pharmacy.-

(2) Seven members of the board must be licensed pharmacists 15 who are residents of this state and who have been engaged in the 16 17 practice of the profession of pharmacy in this state for at 18 least 4 years and, to the extent practicable, represent the 19 various pharmacy practice settings. Of the pharmacist members, 20 three one must be currently engaged in the practice of pharmacy 21 in a community pharmacy, three one must be currently engaged in 22 the practice of pharmacy in a Class II institutional pharmacy or 23 a Modified Class II institutional pharmacy, and one five shall 24 be a pharmacist pharmacists licensed in this state irrespective of practice setting. The remaining two members must be residents 25 26 of the state who have never been licensed as pharmacists and who 27 are in no way connected with the practice of the profession of 28 pharmacy. No person may be appointed as a consumer member who is 29 in any way connected with a drug manufacturer or wholesaler. At 30 least one member of the board must be 60 years of age or older. 31 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
