 8 performed under the direct supervision of a licensed pharmacist

 10 persons under his or her supervision. A ~~pharmacy~~ registered
 11 pharmacy technician, under the supervision of a pharmacist, may
 12 initiate or receive communications with a practitioner or his or
 13 her agent, on behalf of a patient, regarding refill
 14 authorization requests. A licensed pharmacist may ~~not~~ supervise
 15 more than one registered pharmacy technician as ~~unless otherwise~~
 16 permitted by the guidelines to be followed by licensees or
 17 permittees in determining the circumstances under which a

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18 licensed pharmacist may supervise more than one ~~but not more~~
19 ~~than three~~ pharmacy technician technicians. Guidelines adopted
20 by the board must include a provision for automatic board
