27 authorization requests. A licensed pharmacist may not supervise 28 more than one registered pharmacy technician as unless otherwise 29 permitted by the guidelines adopted by the board. The board 30 shall establish guidelines to be followed by licensees or 31 permittees in determining the circumstances under which a 32 licensed pharmacist may supervise more than one registered but 33 not more than three pharmacy technician technicians. Guidelines 34 adopted by the board must provide for automatic board approval 35 of licensed pharmacists who supervise more than one registered pharmacy technician in the operation of an automated pharmacy 36 system or within a pharmacy performing or contracting for the 37 38 performance of centralized prescription filling. 39 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
