A bill to be entitled

An act relating to resident status for tuition purposes; amending s. 1009.21, F.S.; providing criteria for veterans of the Armed Services of the United States, including reserve components thereof, to qualify as residents for tuition purposes; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Present paragraphs (c) through (k) of subsection (10) of section 1009.21, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as paragraphs (d) through (l), respectively, and a new paragraph (c) is added to that subsection, to read:

1009.21 Determination of resident status for tuition purposes.—Students shall be classified as residents or nonresidents for the purpose of assessing tuition in postsecondary educational programs offered by charter technical career centers or career centers operated by school districts, in Florida College System institutions, and in state universities.

- (10) The following persons shall be classified as residents for tuition purposes:
- (c) Veterans of the Armed Services of the United States, including reserve components thereof, who:
- 1. Attend the physical location of an institution of higher learning within this state; or
 - 2. Physically reside in this state while enrolled in an
