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The Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability (Ring) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment

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Delete lines 356 - 369

4 and insert: 5

(f) In collaboration with the department, establishing best practices for the procurement of information technology products and services in order to reduce costs, increase productivity, or improve services. Such practices must include a provision that requires the agency to review all information technology purchases made by state agencies which have a total cost of

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\$250,000 or more, unless a purchase is specifically mandated by the Legislature, for compliance with the standards established pursuant to this section.

- (q) Advising and collaborating with the department in conducting procurement negotiations for information technology products and services that will be used by multiple state agencies, and collaborating with the department in information technology resource acquisition planning.
- (h) Encouraging state agencies, when considering technology infrastructure priorities, to actively seek out and identify opportunities that potentially fit into the public-private partnership model, and develop sustainable partnerships between private entities and units of government in order to accelerate project delivery and provide a source of new or increased funding for other infrastructure needs.
