10 (5) A ~~Any~~ provision of law imposing confidentiality upon
 11 data shared under this section, including, but not limited to, a
 12 ~~any~~ provision imposing penalties for disclosure, applies to
 13 recipients of this data and their employees. Data exchanged
 14 under this section may not be provided to a ~~any~~ person or entity
 15 other than a person or entity administering the tax or licensing
 16 provisions of those provisions of law enumerated in paragraph
 17 (4) (a), and such data may not be used for any purpose other than

18 for enforcing those tax or licensing provisions. This section
19 does not prevent a level-two participant from publishing
20 statistics made confidential so as to prevent the identification
21 of particular accounts, reports, declarations, or returns.
22 However, statistics may not be published if they contain data
23 pertaining to fewer than three taxpayers or if the statistics
24 are prepared for geographic areas below the county level and
25 contain data pertaining to fewer than 10 taxpayers. Statistics
26 published under this subsection must relate only to tourist
27 development taxes imposed under s. 125.0104, the tourist impact
28 tax imposed under s. 125.0108, convention development taxes
29 imposed under s. 212.0305, or the municipal resort tax
30 authorized under chapter 67-930, Laws of Florida.
