- 2. The percentage of students, by school and grade level, in both the highest and lowest quartile demonstrating learning growth in English Language Arts and mathematics.
- (b) Intervention and support strategies used by school boards whose students in both the highest and lowest quartile exceed the statewide average learning growth for students in those quartiles.
- (c) Intervention and support strategies used by school boards whose schools provide educational services to youth in Department of Juvenile Justice programs that demonstrate learning growth in English Language Arts and mathematics that exceed the statewide average learning growth for students in those subjects.
- (d) Included in the report shall be a list of the schools, including schools operating for the purpose of providing educational services to youth in Department of Juvenile Justice programs, for which district school boards have developed intervention and support strategies and an analysis of the various strategies used by the school boards. School reports shall be distributed pursuant to this subsection and s. 1001.42(18)(b) and according to rules adopted by the State Board of Education.
