Section 1. Subsection (12) is added to section 1009.26, Florida Statutes, to read:

(12) A state university or Florida College System institution shall waive out-of-state fees for an honorably discharged veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States, including the National Guard and reserve components thereof, who physically resides in this state while enrolled in the

institution. Tuition and fees charged to a veteran who qualifies for the out-of-state fee waiver under this subsection may not exceed the tuition and fees charged to a resident student. The waiver is applicable for 110 percent of the required credit hours of the degree or certificate program for which the student is enrolled. Each state university and Florida College System institution shall report to the Board of Governors and the State Board of Education, respectively, the number and value of all fee waivers granted annually under this subsection.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
