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House Resolution

A resolution designating May 2014 as "Lupus Awareness Month" in Florida.

5 WHEREAS, each year, the Lupus Foundation of America 6 designates May as national Lupus Awareness Month to show support 7 for the estimated 1.5 million Americans who have lupus, and

8 WHEREAS, lupus is a chronic autoimmune disease in which the 9 immune system is imbalanced causing inflammation and tissue 10 damage to nearly every organ system in the body, and

11 WHEREAS, lupus can affect any part of the body, including 12 the skin, joints, lungs, heart, kidneys, and brain, causing 13 seizures, strokes, heart attacks, miscarriages, and organ 14 failure, and

15 WHEREAS, while lupus most commonly affects women of 16 childbearing age, it can affect people of any age or sex, and

WHEREAS, African-American, Hispanic, Asian-American, and Native-American women are all more likely than Caucasian women to develop lupus, and African-American women are two to three times more likely than Caucasian women to develop lupus, and

21 WHEREAS, lupus can be particularly difficult to diagnose 22 because its symptoms are similar to those of many other 23 diseases, creating challenges in understanding the causes and 24 effects of lupus, and

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25	WHEREAS, current treatments for lupus can have damaging
26	side effects, but there has been only one new drug approved by
27	the United States Food and Drug Administration specifically for
28	the disease in the past 52 years, NOW, THEREFORE,
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30	Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of
31	Florida:
