An act relating to the use of state funds in support of boycotts; providing findings and intent; defining the terms "academic entity," "host country," and "public postsecondary education institution"; prohibiting the use of state funds to fund academic entities that promote discriminatory boycotts; providing limitations; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. <u>Use of state funds in support of boycotts;</u> prohibition.—

students in this state to have access to an education that is not bound by borders and to have the opportunity to obtain a global education. The Legislature further finds that it is important that the state undertake efforts to ensure that its students succeed in a world that is continually becoming more interdependent and that students have access to international postsecondary education institutions. A global education allows students to connect, compete, and cooperate with their peers around the world. Therefore, it is the intent of the Legislature to prohibit the state's public postsecondary education institutions from using state funds to support academic entities that have passed resolutions or taken official actions to

promote discriminatory boycotts and thus limit academic
opportunities.

- (2) For purposes of this section, the term:
- (a) "Academic entity" means an organization that promotes or supports academia in the United States or abroad.
- (b) "Host country" means a country that hosts an international program in which a public postsecondary education institution participates.
- (c) "Public postsecondary education institution" means a Florida College System institution or a state university.
- (3) (a) A public postsecondary education institution may not use state funds provided directly to the institution to fund an academic entity, provide funds for membership in an academic entity, or fund travel or lodging for an institution employee to attend a meeting of an academic entity if the entity has issued a resolution or other official statement, or undertaken an official action, boycotting a host country or a postsecondary education institution located in a host country.
- (b) A public postsecondary education institution is not eligible to receive state funds during the academic year in which the institution is in violation of paragraph (a).
- (c) This section may not limit the attendance by an employee of a public postsecondary education institution at an event of an academic entity that boycotts a host country or a postsecondary education institution located in a host country. Attendance at a meeting of such entity may not be used by the
