14	(1) As used in this section, the term:
15	(a) "Employer" means a hospital, medical or health care
16	facility, individual, firm, partnership, institution,
17	governmental entity, corporation, or association that employs a
18	licensed health care worker.
19	(b) "Licensed health care worker" means an individual
20	licensed under chapter 464 or chapter 468.
21	(2) An employer may not discipline, threaten with discipline,
22	or take retaliatory personnel action against a licensed health
23	care worker in the employment of the employer because the
24	licensed health care worker refuses to take an assignment that
25	is outside of his or her competency or that would give rise to
26	grounds for discipline against the licensed health care worker
