16	Section 1. Paragraphs (c) and (e) of subsection (1) and
17	subsection (7) of section 322.21, Florida Statutes, are amended
18	to read:

21	(1) Except as otherwise provided herein, the fee for:
22	(c) The renewal or extension of a Class E driver license or
23	of a license restricted to motorcycle use only is $\frac{\$25}{\$48}$,
24	except that a delinquent fee of \$15 shall be added for a renewal
25	or extension made within 12 months after the license expiration
26	date. The fee provided in this paragraph includes the fee for
27	driver education provided by s. 1003.48.
28	(e) A replacement driver license issued pursuant to s.
29	322.17 is <u>\$10</u> \$25 . Of this amount <u>\$3</u> \$7 shall be deposited into

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30	the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund and $\$7$ $\$18$ shall be
31	deposited into the General Revenue Fund. Beginning July 1, 2015,
32	or upon completion of the transition of driver license issuance
33	services, if the replacement driver license is issued by the tax
