14	(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if an
15	individual commits a noncriminal traffic infraction under this
16	chapter which causes serious bodily injury or death to a person
17	and within 5 years after that violation, commits another
18	noncriminal traffic infraction under this chapter which causes
19	serious bodily injury or death to a person, the second such
20	violation shall be reclassified as a felony of the third degree,
21	punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
22	(2) As used in this section, the term "serious bodily
23	injury" means an injury to a person, excluding the at-fault
24	driver, which consists of a physical condition that creates a
25	substantial risk of death, serious personal disfigurement, or
26	protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily
27	member or organ.
28	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
