Section 760.81, Florida Statutes, is created to 23 read: 24 760.81 Criminal laws; racial and ethnic impact 25 statements.-(1) As used in this section, the term "minority person" 26

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has the same meaning as provided in s. 288.703.

- (2) Before debate on the floor of a chamber of the Legislature, a racial and ethnic impact statement prepared by the Department of Corrections or, if applicable, the Department of Juvenile Justice shall be attached to any bill, joint resolution, or amendment that proposes a change in the law that creates a criminal offense; significantly changes an existing criminal offense or the penalty for an existing offense; or changes existing sentencing, parole, or probation procedures.
- (3) The racial and ethnic impact statement shall describe the impact of the proposed legislation on minority persons and must be impartial, simple, and understandable. The statement must also include for groups for which data are available the following:
- (a) An estimate of how the proposed legislation would change the racial and ethnic composition of the criminal offender population or recipients of human services.
- (b) A statement of the methodologies and assumptions used in preparing the estimate under paragraph (a).
- (c) If the racial and ethnic impact statement addresses the effect of proposed legislation on the criminal offender population, an estimate of the racial and ethnic composition of the crime victims who may be affected by the proposed legislation.
- Section 2. Section 760.82, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

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53 760.82 State grants; racial and ethnic impact statements.-(1) As used in this section, the term: 54 "Minority person" has the same meaning as provided in 55 (a) 56 s. 288.703. 57 "State agency" has the same meaning as provided in s. (b) 58 110.107. 59 (2) A state agency that awards grants shall require that 60 each grant application include a racial and ethnic impact statement that contains the following information: 61 62 Any disproportionate or unique impact of proposed (a) policies or programs on minority persons in this state. 63 64 (b) A rationale for the existence of policies or programs 65 having a disproportionate or unique impact on minority persons 66 in this state. 67 (c) Evidence of consultation with representatives of minority persons in cases in which a proposed policy or program 68 69 has a disproportionate or unique impact on minority persons in 70 this state. 71 The Department of Management Services shall create and 72 distribute a racial and ethnic impact statement form for state 73 agencies and shall ensure that the statement is included in 74 applications for grants awarded by state agencies. 75 The racial and ethnic impact statement may only be 76 used for informational purposes.

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(5) This section applies only to grants awarded to

corporations or legal entities other than natural persons.
