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16	Section 1. Effective October 1, 2015, subsection (7) of
17	section 316.545, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
18	316.545 Weight and load unlawful; special fuel and motor
19	fuel tax enforcement; inspection; penalty; review
20	(7) There is created within the Department of
21	Transportation the Commercial Motor Vehicle Review Board,
22	consisting of three permanent members who shall be the Secretary
23	of the Department of Transportation, the executive director of
24	the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, and the
25	Commissioner of Agriculture, or their authorized
26	representatives, and four additional members appointed pursuant
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27 <u>to paragraph (b)</u>, which may review any penalty imposed upon any 28 vehicle or person under the provisions of this chapter relating 29 to weights imposed on the highways by the axles and wheels of 30 motor vehicles, to special fuel and motor fuel tax compliance, 31 or to violations of safety regulations.

32 (a) The Secretary of the Department of Transportation or
33 his or her authorized representative shall be the chair of the
34 review board.

35 (b) The Governor shall appoint one member from the road 36 construction industry, one member from the trucking industry, 37 and one member with a general business or legal background. The 38 Commissioner of Agriculture shall appoint one member from the 39 agriculture industry. Each member appointed under this paragraph 40 must be a registered voter and citizen of the state and must possess business experience in the private sector. Members 41 42 appointed pursuant to this paragraph shall each serve a 2-year 43 term. A vacancy occurring during the term of a member appointed 44 under this paragraph shall be filled only for the remainder of 45 the unexpired term. Members of the board appointed under this 46 paragraph may be removed from office by the Governor for 47 misconduct, malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance in office 48 Each permanent member of the review board may designate one 49 additional person to be a member of the review board. 50 Each member, before entering upon his or her official (C) 51 duties, shall take and subscribe to an oath before an official 52 authorized by law to administer oaths that he or she will

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53 honestly, faithfully, and impartially perform the duties 54 devolving upon him or her in office as a member of the review 55 board and that he or she will not neglect any duties imposed upon him or her by s. 316.3025, s. 316.550, or this section The 56 57 review board may execute its responsibilities by meeting as a 58 single group or as subgroups consisting of one authorized 59 representative of each permanent member. The chair of the review board is responsible for the 60 (d) administrative functions of the review board. 61 62 Four members of the board shall constitute a quorum, (e) 63 and the vote of four members shall be necessary for any action taken by the board. A vacancy on the board shall not impair the 64 65 right of a quorum of the board to exercise all of the rights and 66 perform all of the duties of the board. 67 (f) (e) The review board may hold sessions and conduct 68 proceedings at any place within the state. 69 Section 2. The appointment of additional members to the 70 Commercial Motor Vehicle Review Board in accordance with the 71 changes made by this act to s. 316.545, Florida Statutes, shall 72 be made by September 1, 2015, for terms beginning October 1, 73 2015. 74 Section 3. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this 75 act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2015.

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
